


CONCEPT

The Brussels Makers Market is teaming up with Jardin Hospice to offer an open-air summer market from April to September. Based on 3 key criteria: local manufacture, sustainability and originality, the market will host 30 exhibitors in an emblematic city centre location.





Jardin hospice - Grand hospice Rue du Grand Hospice 7, 1000 Bruxelles

Les jardins du Grand hospice is a place open to residents and tourists, providing facilities for the whole district based on two principles: creating links and living together. The gardens are a place where people can come and discover the area while enjoying a drink in the open-air café.

The Grand Hospice is home to a range of brands and sustainable associations sharing premises. In case of rain, the market will be postponed to the next edition. Any fees already paid will be carried over to a future edition until September. If participation does not take place by then, a refund will be issued at the end of the season.
